3. What Information We Collect (and Why)

We collect only the minimum information needed to run the website safely and improve your experience.

a) Information Automatically Collected

Like most educational websites, we collect basic data such as:

- Browser type & device type
- Pages visited
- Time spent on the site
- Anonymous analytics for improving our content

No personally identifiable information (PII) from children is collected without parental consent.

b) Using Google Services (AdSense + Reader Revenue Manager)

Our website uses Google tools that may collect data for:

- Showing safe, family-friendly ads
- Providing subscription or registration options
- Improving website performance
- Preventing fraud or misuse

These tools follow Google's strict child-safety rules.

c) When Users Register or Subscribe

If a parent chooses to register using **Google Account sign-in**, Google may share:

- Name
- Email address

This information is **used only for account access, newsletters, or paid subscriptions**, and never sold to third parties.

Children cannot create accounts or subscribe without a parent/guardian.

4. No Harmful Advertising

Our site only shows **family-safe, educationally appropriate ads** as approved by Google AdSense.

We do **not allow** ads that include:

- Violence
 - Scary or inappropriate content
 - Political or sensitive topics

Advertisers cannot contact or identify your child in any way.

5. No Comments, Chats, or User-Generated Content for Kids

To keep children protected, we intentionally limit interactive features.

We **do not** offer:

- Public comments by children
- Chat rooms
- Forums
- Upload features
- Open messaging between users
